A fully funded UK Government programme designed for adults aged 19+ to help improve mathematics skills, available at no cost to you.

The programme is flexible and personal, offering both face-to-face and online training to fit around you.

What can Multiply do for me?

- You can gain the numeracy skills to help you in everyday situations and learn how to plan and budget better
- You can achieve a better understanding of things like interest rates, mortgages, loans, APR fees, debt management
- You can gain the skills to support younger people or children with homework
- You can improve your wellbeing and feel more confident with everyday tasks such as cooking, shopping, and timekeeping
- You can use what you learn to progress your career or to support further training and education opportunities
